Gush Etzion is a cluster of Israeli communities located directly south of Jerusalem in the West Bank. The core group includes four Jewish agricultural villages that were founded in 1940-1947 and destroyed by the Arab Legion before the outbreak of the 1948 Arab-Israeli War. These settlements were rebuilt after the Six-Day War, along with new communities.

Visit Herodian National Park

The Herodian National Park, named after the ancient fortress built on the site by King Herod, is a towering cone shaped hill. The park is home to ruins on the site which were once a magnificent getaway palace. It is here where the privileged congregated and socialized.
